15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 650.12 of Title 21, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. Every person who, without justifiable or excusable cause and
20	with intent to do bodily harm, commits any assault, battery or
21	assault and battery upon the person of a municipal or county code
22	official who is in the lawful performance of his or her duties of
23	investigating or enforcing the codes, rules or regulations adopted
24	by county legislation or municipal ordinance, upon conviction, is

1	guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the
2	Department of Corrections for a term not to exceed five (5) years,
3	or by a fine not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by
4	both such fine and imprisonment.
5	B. As used in this section, "code official" means any code
6	enforcement official, zoning official, health official, building
7	official or deputies thereof, or other person designated by county
8	legislation or municipal ordinance to lawfully investigate and
9	enforce such legislation or ordinance as adopted by the governing
10	body thereof.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
