9	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; amending 63 O.S. 2011, Section 5006, which
10	relates to powers and duties; requiring legislative
11	approval for request for proposals and contracts; and providing an effective date.
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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 5006, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 5006. A. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Health
18	Care Authority. The Authority shall have the power and duty to:
19	1. Purchase health care benefits for Medicaid recipients, and
20	others who are dependent on the state for necessary medical care, as
21	specifically authorized by law;
22	2. Enter into contracts for the delivery of state-purchased
23	health care and establish standards and criteria which must be met
24	by entities to be eligible to contract with the Authority for the

1 delivery of state-purchased health care. However, the Oklahoma
2 <u>Health Care Authority shall be required to obtain legislative</u>
3 approval for any managed care request for proposal or contract;

3. Develop a proposed standard basic health care benefits
package or packages to be offered by health services providers, for
Medicaid recipients;

7 4. Study all matters connected with the provision of state8 purchased and state-subsidized health care coverage;

9 5. Develop and submit plans, reports and proposals, provide 10 information and analyze areas of public and private health care 11 interaction pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Health Care 12 Authority Act;

6. Serve as a resource for information on state-purchased and state-subsidized health care access, cost containment and related health issues;

16 7. Administer programs and enforce laws placed under the
17 jurisdiction of the Authority pursuant to the Oklahoma Health Care
18 Authority Act, and such other duties prescribed by law;

19 8. Collaborate with and assist the Insurance Commissioner in
20 the development of a Uniform Claim Processing System for use by
21 third-party payors and health care providers;

9. Collaborate with and assist the State Department of Health with the development of licensure standards and criteria for prepaid health plans; and

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10. Exercise all incidental powers which are necessary and
 proper to carry out the purposes of the Oklahoma Health Care
 Authority Act.

4 B. All positions within the Authority shall be unclassified 5 until approval of the annual business and personnel plan submitted 6 by January 1, 1995, by the Governor and the Legislature. In the 7 annual business plan submitted January 1, 1995, the Board shall 8 include a personnel plan which shall list, describe and justify all 9 unclassified positions within the Authority and their compensation. 10 All other employees and positions shall be classified and subject to 11 the provisions of the Merit System of Personnel Administration as 12 provided in the Oklahoma Personnel Act.

## 13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020. 14
