7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to public health; amending 63 O.S.
9 2011, Section 1-232.1, which relates to prenatal
10 classes and risks of drug or alcohol use; providing
for documentation of screening; and providing an
effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-232.1, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 1-232.1 A. All prenatal or postnatal classes offered
17 shall include in their education curriculum the following:

18 1. The risks of drug or alcohol use during pregnancy to the
19 unborn child and to the mother;

20 2. The risks of underage drinking, including information to
21 assist new parents in preventing underage drinking in their own
22 children; and

23 3. Information on screening, assessment, intervention, and
24 referral for treatment of substance dependency.

1 B. All persons licensed to practice medicine and surgery or who
2 are licensed osteopathic physicians and surgeons or who are
3 certified nurse-midwives, advanced nurse practitioners and who
4 provide prenatal, delivery, infant care services and other child or
5 adult health services related to maternal and infant care shall
6 provide ~~access to~~ screening, assessment, intervention, and referral
7 for treatment of substance dependency. Documentation of screening
8 shall be reflected in the health record of the mother and made
9 available to all providers who will be providing care to the mother
10 and infant. Positive screening shall reflect appropriate referral.

11 C. Education and prevention materials regarding the risks of
12 alcohol or drug use during pregnancy and the risks of underage
13 drinking shall be made readily available by those governed by this
14 section and shall be distributed to individuals who report to their
15 health care provider they are pregnant or are planning to become
16 pregnant.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
