8                               COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9           An Act relating to memorial highways and bridges;  
10          designating the WWII Doolittle Raider - Bombardier  
11          Sgt. Robert James "R.J." Stephens Memorial Bridge;  
12          designating the Keith N. Cantrell, PFC U.S. Army  
13          Memorial Bridge; designating the Paul Blevins, Jr.  
14          and Michael Rogers Memorial Highway; designating the  
15          Stiles Brothers Vietnam Veteran Memorial Bridge;  
16          designating South Mickey Mantle Boulevard;  
17          designating the Terry L. Hoggatt Memorial Highway;  
18          designating the Jennifer McClendon Memorial Bridge;  
19          designating the Major Charles E. Stiles Memorial  
20          Bridge; designating the CSM Junior H. Honeycutt  
21          Memorial Highway; providing for codification; and  
22          providing an effective date.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24           SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

          The bridge over Elk Creek on State Highway 9 located  
approximately one (1) mile west of Hobart in Kiowa County shall be  
designated as the "WWII Doolittle Raider - Bombardier Sgt. Robert

1 James "R.J." Stephens Memorial Bridge". The Department of  
2 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that  
3 name to be placed on the bridge.

4 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.309 of Title 69, unless  
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The bridge over Flat Creek on State Highway 34 located  
8 approximately one-half (0.5) mile north of West Madison Avenue near  
9 the town of Carter in Beckham County shall be designated as the  
10 "Keith N. Cantrell, PFC U.S. Army Memorial Bridge". The Department  
11 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing  
12 that name to be placed on the bridge.

13 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.310 of Title 69, unless  
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The section of State Highway 82 beginning at the intersection of  
17 U.S. Highway 62 and extending southeasterly to the intersection of  
18 East Flournory Road south of Tahlequah in Cherokee County shall be  
19 designated as the "Paul Blevins, Jr. and Michael Rogers Memorial  
20 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable  
21 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

22 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.311 of Title 69, unless  
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1       The bridge over Muddy Boggy Creek on State Highway 43 located  
2 approximately one (1) mile east of the town of Coalgate in Coal  
3 County shall be designated as the "Stiles Brothers Vietnam Veteran  
4 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause  
5 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the  
6 bridge.

7       SECTION 5.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.312 of Title 69, unless  
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10       The section of U.S. Highway 69 in Ottawa County beginning at the  
11 intersection of Newman Road then extending north to the intersection  
12 of Commerce Street in the City of Commerce shall be designated as  
13 "South Mickey Mantle Boulevard". The Department of Transportation  
14 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be  
15 placed on the highway

16       SECTION 6.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.313 of Title 69, unless  
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19       The section of State Highway 18 beginning at Deep Rock Road and  
20 extending north three (3) miles in Payne County shall be designated  
21 as the "Terry L. Hoggatt Memorial Highway". The Department of  
22 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that  
23 name to be placed on the highway.

1       SECTION 7.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.314 of Title 69, unless  
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge over  
5 South 129th Avenue on State Highway 51, also known as the Broken  
6 Arrow Expressway, in Broken Arrow, Tulsa County shall be designated  
7 as the "Jennifer McClendon Memorial Bridge". The Department of  
8 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that  
9 name to be placed on the bridge.

10       SECTION 8.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.315 of Title 69, unless  
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge over Lee  
14 Boulevard on Interstate 44 in the City of Lawton in Comanche County  
15 shall be designated as the "Major Charles E. Stiles Memorial  
16 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable  
17 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

18       SECTION 9.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.316 of Title 69, unless  
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of State  
22 Highway 28A beginning at the intersection of State Highway 66 near  
23 the Town of Foyil extending east to the intersection of Interstate  
24 44 in Rogers County shall be designated as the "CSM Junior H.

1 Honeycutt Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall  
2 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on  
3 the highway.

4 SECTION 10. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
