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20	An Act relating to the Department of Transportation;
21	amending 69 O.S. 2011, Sections 302 and 305, which relate to transportation; modifying appointment of
22	members of the Transportation Commission; providing for service at pleasure of appointing authority;
23	prohibiting voting on certain issues; making Director of the Department ex officio member; allowing vote of
24	Director in case of tie; deleting obsolete language; authorizing Governor to appoint and set compensation

1	of the Director; specifying methods of removing
2	Director from office; and declaring an emergency.
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4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
5	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 302, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Section 302. (a) A. The State Transportation Commission shall
8	consist of <u>an at-large member and</u> one (1) member from each of eight
9	districts of the state, such districts to serve as the maintenance
10	districts and to include the area as follows:
11	District 1. Wagoner, Cherokee, Adair, Sequoyah, Muskogee,
12	Okmulgee, McIntosh and Haskell Counties.
13	District 2. Pittsburg, Latimer, LeFlore, McCurtain, Pushmataha,
14	Atoka, Choctaw, Bryan and Marshall Counties.
15	District 3. Lincoln, Cleveland, McClain, Garvin, Pottawatomie,
16	Okfuskee, Seminole, Hughes, Pontotoc, Coal and Johnston Counties.
17	District 4. Payne, Logan, Canadian, Kingfisher, Garfield,
18	Grant, Kay, Noble and Oklahoma Counties.
19	District 5. Roger Mills, Dewey, Custer, Washita, Beckham,
20	Greer, Kiowa, Harmon, Jackson, Blaine, and Tillman Counties.
21	District 6. Cimarron, Texas, Beaver, Harper, Woods, Alfalfa,
22	Ellis, Major and Woodward Counties.
23	District 7. Carter, Love, Murray, Grady, Comanche, Stephens,
24	Cotton, Caddo and Jefferson Counties.

1	District 8. Osage, Pawnee, Nowata, Creek, Craig, Ottawa,
2	Rogers, Mayes, Delaware, Washington and Tulsa Counties.
3	(b) <u>B.</u> The members of the Commission shall be appointed by the
4	Governor, by and with the consent of the Senate, such appointment to
5	have full force and effect and to be submitted to the Senate for its
6	confirmation at the first session of the Senate after such
7	appointment is made. No Commissioner shall be entitled to the
8	payment of salary, or to perform any service, until his appointment
9	is confirmed by the Senate, if the Senate then be in session; if the
10	Senate be not in session, then such Commissioner may serve and draw
11	his salary until a special or regular session convenes; and if his
12	appointment is not then confirmed within twenty (20) days, he shall
13	cease to perform such services and cease to draw his salary. Each
14	of the Commissioners thus appointed shall, at the time of his
15	appointment, be a citizen and resident of the district for which he
16	shall have been appointed for at least three (3) years prior to the
17	date of his appointment. Not more than one Commissioner shall
18	reside in any one district, as defined herein, at any time while
19	serving on the Commission. Each Commissioner thus appointed and
20	confirmed shall, after the first term of office as herein provided,
21	serve for a term of eight (8) years, and unless he is reappointed by
22	the Governor and confirmed by the Senate within twenty (20)
23	legislative days his services are automatically terminated and he
24	shall cease to draw his salary, or any perquisites or emoluments as

1	a Commissioner; provided, that in the event the Governor's appointee
2	is not confirmed by the Senate within ten (10) days from the date
3	his name is submitted, then the Governor shall submit a further
4	appointee for confirmation; and during his term of office may be
5	removed by the Governor at his pleasure. The terms of office shall
6	be as follows: Two Commissioners shall serve until the 15th day of
7	February, 1969; two Commissioners shall serve until the 15th day of
8	February, 1971; two Commissioners shall serve until the 15th day of
9	February, 1973; and two Commissioners shall serve until the 15th day
10	of February, 1975; and the Covernor, at the time of making the first
11	appointment, shall, in his order of appointment, designate the term
12	each Commissioner so appointed shall serve. Thereafter the term of
13	each Commissioner appointed and confirmed shall expire the 15th day
14	of February in the eighth year after his appointment, and in case of
15	death, resignation, or removal, the place shall be filled by
16	appointment by the Governor for the remainder of the term. Such
17	appointments also shall be confirmed by the Senate. The members of
18	the Commission each shall receive an annual salary of Four Thousand
19	Eight Hundred Dollars (\$4,800.00), payable monthly, and each shall
20	be entitled to receive travel expenses pursuant to the State Travel
21	Reimbursement Act, Section 500.1 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
22	Statutes as follows:
23	1. Members from Districts 5, 6, 7 and 8 and the at-large member

24 shall be appointed by the Governor;

1	2. Members from Districts 2 and 3 shall be appointed by the
2	Speaker of the House of Representatives; and
3	3. Members from Districts 1 and 4 shall be appointed by the
4	President Pro Tempore of the Senate.
5	C. Each member shall serve at the pleasure of his or her
6	appointing authority and may be removed or replaced without cause.
7	Any member of the Commission shall be prohibited from voting on any
8	issue in which the member has a direct financial interest. The
9	Governor Director of the Department of Transportation shall be an ex
10	officio member of the Commission, but shall be entitled to vote only
11	in case of a tie vote.
12	(c) Provided, that persons serving as members of the State
13	Highway Commission created by Section 301 of this title, when this
14	Code becomes effective shall serve as members of the State
15	Transportation Commission created by this Code for the remainder of
16	the terms for which they were appointed, in the positions on the
17	latter Commission having corresponding terms of office, or until
18	such positions are filled as herein provided. Future Gubernatorial
19	appointments shall be made from districts as directed by this act
20	D. The members of the Commission each shall receive an annual
21	salary of Four Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$4,800.00), payable
22	monthly, and each shall be entitled to receive travel expenses
23	pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
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1SECTION 2.AMENDATORY69 O.S. 2011, Section 305, is2amended to read as follows:

3	Section 305. There is hereby created the office of the Director
4	of the Department of Transportation, who shall be elected by a
5	majority vote of the entire Commission appointed by the Governor
6	with the advice and consent of the Senate and who shall serve at the
7	pleasure of the Commission. The Director shall receive an annual
8	salary to be fixed by a majority vote of the entire Commission from
9	appropriations made by the Legislature Governor and may be removed
10	or replaced without cause. Compensation for the Director shall be
11	determined by the Governor. The Director may be removed from office
12	by a two-thirds $(2/3)$ vote of the members elected to and
13	constituting each chamber of the Legislature.
14	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
