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9 An Act relating to state government; requiring the
10 Office of Management and Enterprise Services to
11 notify state agencies regarding certain actions;
12 permitting agencies to respond regarding certain
13 actions; requiring certain notice; providing certain
14 exception; providing for codification; and providing
15 an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.202 of Title 62, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. In all instances in which the Office of Management and
21 Enterprise Services changes a policy affecting a state agency, the
22 Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall provide the
23 affected agency with written notice no fewer than thirty (30) days
24 in advance of the policy's implementation.

1 B. During the period after an affected agency has been
2 notified, and prior to the implementation of the policy, the
3 affected agency shall be permitted to respond to the Office of
4 Management and Enterprise Services and request to be exempted from
5 the policy change, or request modifications to the policy. The
6 affected agency shall be given a final notice in written format
7 explaining any changes to a policy prior to its implementation.

8 C. The provisions of this act shall not apply to any policy
9 changes made necessary by federal law or policy, or any other policy
10 changes deemed an emergency by the Office of Management and
11 Enterprise Services.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
