1 ~~Commissioner~~ Chief of Administration who is otherwise statutorily
2 eligible shall have a right to return to the previous position of
3 the employee without any loss of rights, privileges or benefits
4 immediately upon completion of the duties as ~~Assistant Commissioner~~
5 Chief of Administration, provided the employee is not otherwise
6 disqualified.

7 B. When traveling with the Governor or at his or her request:

8 1. Those personnel assigned by the Commissioner for executive
9 security shall be allowed their actual and necessary traveling
10 expenses, upon claims approved by the Commissioner, and shall
11 receive, in addition to base salary, an additional One Hundred
12 Seventy-five Dollars (\$175.00) per month; and

13 2. Those personnel serving as noncommissioned pilots in the
14 Department of Public Safety shall be allowed their actual and
15 necessary traveling expenses, upon claims approved by the
16 Commissioner.

17 C. Any person appointed to the position of ~~Assistant~~
18 ~~Commissioner~~ Chief of Administration of the Department of Public
19 Safety shall be eligible for retirement participation as a member of
20 the Highway Patrol Division in the Oklahoma Law Enforcement
21 Retirement System if such person at the time of appointment
22 satisfies the age qualifications of an Oklahoma Highway Patrolman as
23 provided in subsection B of Section 2-105 of this title; ~~however,~~
24 and is otherwise eligible to participate in the retirement program;

1 otherwise, the Chief of Administration shall participate in the
2 Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement upon appointment. However, the
3 ~~Assistant Commissioner~~ Chief of Administration shall be eligible for
4 participation in only one retirement system and shall elect in
5 writing the system in which ~~he~~ the Chief of Administration intends
6 to participate.

7 D. The salaries of the employees of the Department of Public
8 Safety, shall be governed by and in accordance with the procedures
9 established by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services,
10 unless otherwise provided by law.

11 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
