For purposes of Sections 3601.1 through 19 3603 of this title, the term "employee" means a full-time employee 20 or any number of part-time employees whose combined weekly hours of 21 employment equal those of a full-time employee, but shall not 22 include temporary employees working on a seasonal basis between May 23 1 and October 31. 24
