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9	An Act relating to brewer licenses; amending Section
10	14, Chapter 366, O.S.L. 2016, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 315, O.S.L. 2018 (37A O.S. Supp.
11	2018, Section 2-102), which relates to brewer license; adding cider; limiting service area;
12	restricting service area to certain aged persons; defining term; updating statutory reference; and
13	providing an effective date.
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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 14, Chapter 366, O.S.L.
17	2016, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 315, O.S.L. 2018 (37A
18	O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 2-102), is amended to read as follows:
19	Section 2-102. A. A brewer license shall authorize the holder
20	thereof:
21	1. To manufacture, bottle, package and store beer or cider on
22	the licensed premises; and
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- 2. To sell beer <u>or cider</u> in this state to holders of beer distributor licenses and to sell beer <u>or cider</u> out of this state to qualified persons.
  - B. A small brewer license shall authorize the holder thereof:
- 1. To manufacture, bottle, package and store beer or cider produced by the licensee on licensed premises;
- 2. To sell beer <u>or cider</u> in this state to holders of beer distributor licenses and retail licenses or to sell beer <u>or cider</u> out of this state to qualified persons;
- 3. To serve free samples of beer <u>or cider</u> produced by the licensee to visitors twenty-one (21) years of age or older;
- 4. To sell beer or cider produced by the licensee for either on-premises or off-premises consumption to consumers on the brewery premises, or on premises located contiguous thereto;
- 5. To sell beer <u>or cider</u> at public events such as trade shows or festivals;
- 6. To purchase wine in retail containers from the holder of a wholesaler license or as specifically provided by law; and
- 7. To sell, offer for sale and possess wine for on-premises consumption.
- 21 C. Nothing in this act the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control
  22 Act shall prohibit the holder of a small brewer license from also
  23 holding or owning an interest in the holder of a brewpub license.

D. For purposes of this section, no visitor may sample more
than a total of twelve (12) fluid ounces of beer or cider per day.
The brewer must restrict the distribution and consumption of beer
samples or cider to an the serving area within the licensed premises
designated by the brewer as defined in this subsection. A current
floor plan that includes the designated sampling serving area must
be on file with the ABLE Commission. No visitor under twenty-one
(21) years of age shall be permitted to enter this designated
sampling serving area when samples are being distributed or
consumed. Accompanied visitors under twenty-one (21) years of age
shall be allowed anywhere on the premises except for a serving area.
Samples of beer or cider served by a brewery under this section
shall not be considered a sale of beer or cider within the meaning
of Article XXVIIIA of the Oklahoma Constitution or Section 1-103 of
this title; however, such samples of beer or cider shall be
considered beer or cider removed or withdrawn from the brewery for
use or consumption within the meaning of Section 5-110 of this title
for excise tax determination and reporting requirements. Sales and
sampling may only occur between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00
a.m. For purposes of this subsection, "serving area" means the area
of the bar where drinks are sold, prepared and served to paying
customers and shall not include other areas of the brewery where
customers consume purchased products.

1	E. A small brewer self-distribution license shall authorize
2	holders of a small brewer license to distribute beer <u>or cider</u>
3	produced only by such licensee to a holder of a retail beer license,
4	retail spirits license, mixed beverage license, beer and wine
5	license, caterer's license, special event license, public event
6	license, winemaker license charitable auction license or brewpub
7	license. A small brewer shall elect whether it will distribute
8	through a distributor or self-distribute in a subject territory;
9	however, a small brewer may not elect to do both simultaneously in a
10	subject territory. The election shall be made through notice to the
11	ABLE Commission. Any changes to the election shall require
12	immediate notification to the ABLE Commission before the change in
13	election will take effect. A small brewer that elects to self-
14	distribute in multiple territories shall only be required to have
15	one small brewer self-distribution license.
16	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
