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9 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
10 2011, Section 802, as amended by Section 1, Chapter
11 48, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 802),
12 which relates to commercial driver training;
13 requiring content related to human trafficking be
14 included in course of study; requiring regular review
15 and updating of content; requiring certain
16 collaboration; requiring certain publication in
17 certain manner; updating statutory reference; and
18 providing an effective date.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 802, as
21 amended by Section 1, Chapter 48, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp. 2018,
22 Section 802), is amended to read as follows:

23 Section 802. A. The Commissioner shall adopt and prescribe
24 such regulations concerning the administration and enforcement of
25 ~~this act~~ Section 801 et seq. of this title as are necessary to carry
26 out the intent of this act and to protect the public. The

1 Commissioner or his authorized representative shall inspect the
2 school facilities and equipment of applicants and licensees and
3 examine applicants for instructor's licenses.

4 B. The Commissioner shall administer and enforce the provisions
5 of this act, and may call upon the State Superintendent of Public
6 Instruction for assistance in developing and formulating appropriate
7 regulations.

8 C. 1. The Commissioner may require that the course of study
9 for training students for Class A, B or C commercial licenses shall
10 include training on the recognition, prevention and reporting of
11 human trafficking. If required, the Commissioner shall regularly
12 review and update the training to take into account changes and
13 trends in human trafficking. ~~To establish the content of training,~~
14 ~~the~~ The Commissioner shall collaborate with:

15 ~~a.~~ organizations that specialize in the recognition and
16 prevention of human trafficking, ~~and~~

17 ~~b.~~ ~~the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous~~
18 ~~Drugs Control.~~

19 2. The Commissioner ~~shall publish content~~ may identify and
20 establish industry specific materials for use in the instruction
21 required on the recognition, prevention and effective reporting of
22 human trafficking ~~in a manner that is likely to be read by holders~~
23 ~~of or~~ people training to obtain a Class A, B or C commercial
24 license.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
