14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 11, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 11. A. If there be in any other provision of the laws
18	of this state a provision making any specific act or omission
19	criminal and providing the punishment therefor, and there be in this
20	title any provision or section making the same act or omission a
21	criminal offense or prescribing the punishment therefor, that
22	offense and the punishment thereof, shall be governed by the special
23	provisions made in relation thereto, and not by the provisions of
24	this title. But an act or omission which is made punishable in

different ways by different provisions of this title may be punished 1 under any of such provisions, except that in cases specified in 2 3 Section 434 of this act or Section Sections 51.1 and 54 of this 4 title, the punishments therein prescribed are substituted for those 5 prescribed for a first offense, but in no case can a criminal act or omission be punished under more than one section of law; and an 6 acquittal or conviction and sentence under one section of law, bars 7 the prosecution for the same act or omission under any other section 8 9 of law.

B. Provided, however, notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any offense, including traffic offenses, in violation of the laws of this state which is not otherwise punishable by a term of imprisonment or confinement shall be punishable by a term of imprisonment not to exceed one day in the discretion of the court, in addition to any fine prescribed by law.

SECTION 2. REPEALER 22 O.S. 2011, Section 16, is hereby
repealed.
SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
