13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 36.1 of Title 62, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahomans
18	Virtually Everywhere Act of 2019". The Oklahomans Virtually
19	Everywhere Act creates a statewide initiative that allows Oklahomans
20	to provide their expertise throughout the world without leaving
21	their communities by Oklahoma becoming the leader in telepresence
22	and virtual presence.
23	B. For purposes of this section:
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1. "Telepresence" means the ability of people who are not
 2 physically present with each other to collaborate and interact with
 3 others in meetings, conferences, office work and other contexts as
 4 though they were physically present; and

2. "Virtual presence" means that the interactions between
individuals and groups virtually present in meetings, conferences,
office work and other social contexts are indistinguishable between
those who are physically present and those who are not.

9 С. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall lead 10 an effort in conjunction with OneNet, the State Board of Career and 11 Technology Education, State Department of Education, Oklahoma 12 Department of Libraries, Oklahoma Department of Commerce and the Office of Management and Enterprise Services on behalf of all state 13 agencies to create a research and development proposal to make 14 15 Oklahoma a leader in telepresence, with the ultimate goal of being a leader in virtual presence as the technology matures. The proposal 16 shall include a proposed budget and be prepared for the legislative 17 session following the effective date of this act. Each agency in 18 this subsection shall designate a liaison for this effort. 19

20 D. The proposal shall:

Include a proposed budget and be prepared for the budget
 hearings of the legislative session;

Include a strategy for training Oklahoma organizations to use existing technology for telepresence and virtual presence; and 2 Include an overview of the current state of telepresence in 3 4. Oklahoma education, government and business, with the following: 4 5 a. research and actions necessary to become a leader in telepresence in education, 6 7 b. research and actions necessary to become a leader in telepresence in government, 8 9 с. research and actions necessary to become a leader in telepresence in business, 10 11 d. research and actions necessary to become a leader in 12 telepresence in Oklahoma rural communities, identification of potential partners and sources of 13 e. matching or other funds, 14 f. strategy for training Oklahoma organizations to use 15 existing technology for telepresence and virtual 16 presence, and 17 any additional information deemed necessary by the 18 g. participants. 19 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 21 22 23 24
