3 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.289 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge over U.S. Highway 266 on U.S. Highway 69 within the
7 municipal limits of Checotah shall be designated as the "Paul Henry
8 Carr Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
9 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
10 highway.

11 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.290 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The section of U.S. Highway 77 beginning at the south edge of
15 the municipal limits of Marietta extending southwesterly to the
16 northern municipal limits of Thackerville in Love County shall be
17 designated as the "Trooper Leon H. Brown Memorial Highway". The
18 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
19 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

20 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.291 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The bridge over Interstate 35 on 4th Street within the municipal
24 limits of Moore shall be designated as the "1LT Damon Leehan

1 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
2 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
3 highway.

4 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.292 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The portion of State Highway 82 beginning at the junction of
8 State Highway 82 and West Gideon Road in Cherokee County extending
9 southeast to the junction of State Highway 82 and North Elm Grove
10 Road in Cherokee County shall be designated as the "Deputy Sean
11 Cookson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
12 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
13 the highway.

14 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.293 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The bridge over Martin Luther King Avenue on Interstate 44
18 within the municipal limits of Oklahoma City shall be designated as
19 the "Senator E. Melvin Porter Memorial Bridge". The Department of
20 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
21 name to be placed on the highway.

22 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.294 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of State Highway 54 beginning at the Custer County -
2 Washita County line extending southerly to the intersection with
3 State Highway 54B in Washita County shall be designated as the
4 "Deputy Sheriff Clifford Phillip Payne Memorial Highway". The
5 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
6 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

7 SECTION 9. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 307, O.S.L.
8 2018 (69 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 1698.271), is amended to read as
9 follows:

10 Section 1698.271 The bridge on ~~U.S. Highway 283~~ Interstate 40
11 over the North Fork Red River ~~south of the municipal limits of~~ near
12 the town of Sayre in Beckham County shall be designated as the "SSG
13 Christopher ~~Michael~~ Michael Hake Memorial Bridge". The Department
14 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
15 that name to be placed on the bridge.

16 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.295 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The section of State Highway 18 beginning at Lone Chimney Road
20 extending north to the intersection with State Highway 64 in Pawnee
21 County shall be designated as the "Undersheriff Monty Johnson
22 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
23 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
24 highway.

1 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.296 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of U.S. Highway 64 Business beginning at West 23rd
5 Street South extending north to the intersection of West Southside
6 Blvd. in the City of Muskogee in Muskogee County shall be designated
7 as the "Councilwoman Avalon Reese Memorial Highway". The Department
8 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
9 that name to be placed on the highway.

10 **SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified**
11 **in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.297 of Title 69, unless**
12 **there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:**

13 The bridge over Big Creek on State Highway 10 located 1.8 miles
14 east of the Craig County line shall be designated as the "Private
15 First Class George Henry Taylor Memorial Bridge". The Department of
16 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
17 name to be placed on the bridge.

18 **SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified**
19 **in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.298 of Title 69, unless**
20 **there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:**

21 The section of State Highway 5 beginning at the intersection of
22 South Boundary Avenue and extending south and easterly to the
23 intersection of N2680 County Road in Cotton County shall be
24 designated as the "City Marshal Jefferson Davis "J.D." Graham

1 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
2 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
3 highway.

4 **SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified**
5 **in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.299 of Title 69, unless**
6 **there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:**

7 The section of State Highway 5 west of the municipal limits of
8 Temple beginning on the west side of State Highway 65 South and
9 extending west to the intersection of N2640 County Road in Cotton
10 County shall be designated as the "Sheriff Horace H. "Bill" Dyer
11 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
12 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
13 highway.

14 **SECTION 15. AMENDATORY Section 5, Chapter 246, O.S.L.**
15 **2018 (69 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 1698.281), is amended to read as**
16 **follows:**

17 Section 1698.281. The portion of U.S. Highway 69 beginning at
18 the junction of U.S. Highway 69 and W. Shawnee Street in Muskogee
19 County extending north to the junction of U.S. Highway 69 and W.
20 Fern Mountain Road in Muskogee County shall be designated as the
21 "Tuskegee Airman 2nd Lt Faythe McGinnis Memorial Highway". The
22 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
23 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

1 SECTION 16. AMENDATORY Section 12, Chapter 372, O.S.L.

2 2013, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 61, O.S.L. 2015 (69 O.S.

3 Supp. 2018, Section 1600.1), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1600.1. Highways, bridges, and other facilities which
5 are part of the state highway system may be considered for

6 dedication in honor of individuals deserving of commendation for

7 their active involvement in the project or for outstanding service

8 to the nation, this state, or their community. ~~Persons proposed to~~

9 ~~be so honored shall have been deceased not less than three (3) years~~

10 ~~prior to consideration.~~ The provisions of this section shall not

11 apply to the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway

12 system designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces,

13 members of law enforcement or firefighters fallen in the performance

14 of their duties. The provisions of this section shall also not

15 apply to the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway

16 system designed to honor Medal of Honor recipients both living and

17 deceased. Proposals for the dedication of state highway facilities

18 should specifically state the accomplishments upon which the

19 proposal is based.

20 SECTION 17. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
