16	established. The school shall be governed by a board of trustees as
17	created in this section.
18	B. 1. The board of trustees of the Oklahoma School for the
19	Visual and Performing Arts shall be authorized to continue until
20	July 1, 2020, and consist of the following members:
21	a. four (4) ex officio nonvoting members as follows:

  President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of

- The terms of office of the initial members appointed by the
   Governor shall be as follows:
- a. four members shall serve initial terms of two (2)
   years,
- b. four members shall serve initial terms of four (4)
  years, and
- 16 c. three members shall serve initial terms of six (6)
  17 years.

At the expiration of the terms of the initial members
 appointed by the Governor, their successors shall be appointed for
 terms of six (6) years.

D. Vacancies in the office of an appointed member shall be filled for the unexpired term by the authority making the original appointment.

E. Members of the board shall receive no compensation for their
 service, but shall receive travel reimbursement as follows:

3 1. Legislative members of the board shall be reimbursed in 4 accordance with the provisions of Section 456 of Title 74 of the 5 Oklahoma Statutes; and

2. Nonlegislative members of the board shall be reimbursed by
their appointing authorities pursuant to the State Travel
8 Reimbursement Act.

9 F. The board of trustees shall prepare a budget request for the 10 Oklahoma School for the Visual and Performing Arts and shall submit 11 the budget request to the Legislature and the Governor by October 1 12 of each year. The board of trustees may accept gifts of real and 13 personal property, money and other things, and use or dispose of the 14 same in accordance with the directions of the donors or grantors 15 thereof.

16 G. The board of trustees is authorized to purchase, own and 17 acquire by lease or gift such motor vehicles as are reasonably 18 necessary for the implementation of the programs of the Oklahoma 19 School for the Visual and Performing Arts.

 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
