AMENDATORY 12 amended to read as follows: Section 5003.8. A. In order to ensure that the Oklahoma 13 Department of Commerce is effectively implementing its mission, 14 15 purpose and objectives, the Department shall publish an annual report setting forth in detail the operations and programs conducted 16 by it pursuant to this act or to other legislation. The report 17 shall review both statewide progress and departmental progress 18 according to several measures including objective measures listed in 19 the Department's five-year plan. The Department shall present this 20 report to the Governor and the Legislature. The annual report shall 21 specifically account for ways in which the needs, mission and 22 programs of the Department described in this act have been carried 23 out and recommendations shall specifically note what changes in the 24

activities of the Department and the programs it administers and of state government are necessary to better address the mission described in this act. The Department shall distribute its annual report by such means that will make it widely available to communities, firms and local economic development managers

B. In addition to subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma

Department of Commerce shall be responsible for collecting data and

publishing on their website an annual report to be called the

"Future of Oklahoma Industry and Labor (FOIL) Report". The report

shall analyze and describe the current and predictable trends of the

State of Oklahoma's jobs, industries and labor workforce. The

report shall include an interactive map covering the various regions

of the state to show trends in specific job markets, growth

industries, and labor workforce shortages as analyzed in the

published report. The first report shall be published on July 1,

2021, and a report shall be due each July 1 thereafter.

C. In a collaborative effort, the following agencies and entities shall work in conjunction with the Department to assist in the collection and analysis of data and the formulation of each annual FOIL report specified in subsection B of this section. Each shall contribute and analyze data for the Department and shall be required to maintain a link connection to the FOIL report and interactive map on their separate websites:
