14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2011, Section 17-107, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 17-107. If a municipality does not file a copy of its
18	audit or agreed-upon-procedures report as provided in Section 17-105
19	of this title, the State Auditor and Inspector shall notify the
20	Oklahoma Tax Commission which shall withhold from the municipality
21	its monthly allocations of gasoline taxes until the audit report is
22	filed. If a report is not filed within two (2) years one (1) year
23	after the close of the fiscal year, the funds being withheld shall
24	be remitted by the Oklahoma Tax Commission to the county in which

1	the incorporated city or town is located and deposited to the county
2	highway fund of that county to be used as otherwise provided by law
3	the Special Investigative Unit Auditing Fund of the State Auditor's
4	Office.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
