An Act relating to special license plates; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 1135.5), which relates to special license plates; allowing for personalization of certain license plates; creating the Bison License Plate and providing for expenditures thereof; providing for design consultation; updating statutory reference; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1135.5. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide financial assistance as provided by this section.

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of

1 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
2 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
3 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

4 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
5 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
6 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.
7 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special
8 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
9 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
10 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
11 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

12 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
13 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
14 applications for special license plates authorized under this
15 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
16 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
17 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
18 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
19 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
20 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
21 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
22 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
23 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

1 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
2 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
3 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
4 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
5 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
6 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
7 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
8 removed from the vehicle.

9 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
10 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
11 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
12 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
13 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
14 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
15 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
16 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
17 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

18 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
19 follows:

20 1. University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
22 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
23 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
24 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

1 2. Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
3 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
4 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
5 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
6 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
7 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
8 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
9 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
10 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
11 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
12 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
13 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
14 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
15 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
16 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

17 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
18 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
19 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
20 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
21 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
22 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
23 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
24 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to

1 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
2 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
3 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
4 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
5 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
6 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
7 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
8 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

9 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
10 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
11 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
12 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

13 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
14 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
15 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
16 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
17 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
18 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
19 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
20 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
21 plates.

22 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
23 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
24 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
3 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
4 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
5 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
6 the prevention of child abuse.

7 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
8 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

9 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plate -
10 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
11 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
12 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
13 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
14 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
15 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
16 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
17 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
18 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
19 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
20 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
21 issued;

22 7. Oklahoma History License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
24 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee

1 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
2 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

3 8. Historic Route 66 License Plate - such:

4 a. vehicle plates shall be designed to honor historic
5 Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As
6 provided in this section, an amount of the fee
7 collected for each vehicle license plate shall be
8 apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society
9 Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Route 66
10 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and

11 b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation
12 with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. The
13 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
14 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66
15 Association, Inc., for any licensing fees which may be
16 required in order to use the Oklahoma Route 66
17 Association, Inc., logo or design. The licensing
18 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma
19 Route 66 Association, Inc., of not more than Twenty
20 Dollars (\$20.00) for each motorcycle license plate
21 issued;

22 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
24 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal

1 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
2 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
3 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
4 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plate - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
7 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
8 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
9 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
10 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
11 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
12 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
13 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
14 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
15 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

16 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
18 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
19 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
20 Revolving Fund;

21 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
22 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
23 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
24 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims

1 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
2 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
3 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
4 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
5 provide services to crime victims;

6 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plate - such plates
7 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
8 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
9 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
10 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
11 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
12 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
13 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

14 14. Four-H Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
15 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
16 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
18 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
19 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
20 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
21 Section 1104.4 of this title;

22 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
24 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in

1 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
2 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the
3 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount
4 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section
5 1104.3 of this title;

6 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates
7 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
8 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
9 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
10 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
11 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
12 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
13 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
14 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
17 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
18 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
19 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
20 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
21 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
22 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
23 follows:
24

- 1 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
2 Reform Revolving Fund,
3 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
4 Education Revolving Fund,
5 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
6 Career Technology Fund, and
7 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
8 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
9 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
10 Oklahoma Statutes.

11 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
12 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
13 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
14 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
15 paragraph;

16 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plate -
17 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
18 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
19 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
20 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
21 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
22 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
23 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
24 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.

1 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
2 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
3 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
4 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
5 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
6 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
7 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
8 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
9 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

10 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plate - such plates
11 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
12 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued
13 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
14 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
15 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax
16 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
17 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
18 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
19 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment
20 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
21 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

22 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
23 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
24 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and

1 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
2 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
3 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
4 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
5 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
6 of this title;

7 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
8 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
9 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
10 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
11 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
12 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
13 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
14 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

15 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall
16 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant
17 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and
18 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and
19 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of
20 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be
21 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the
22 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.
23 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited
24 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be

1 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of
2 the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act specifically for
3 created families;

4 23. Choose Life License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
5 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
6 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
7 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
8 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
9 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
10 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
11 this title;

12 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
13 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
14 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
15 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
16 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
17 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
18 Section 1104.7 of this title;

19 25. Lions Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed
20 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
21 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
22 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
23 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
24 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation

1 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
2 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
3 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
4 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
5 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
6 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

7 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
9 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
10 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
11 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
12 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
13 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
14 Section 1104.8 of this title;

15 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
16 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
17 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
18 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
19 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
20 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
21 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
22 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
23 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
24 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use

1 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
2 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
3 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
4 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
5 plate issued;

6 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates
7 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
8 support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be
9 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon.
10 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
11 agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon for any licensing
12 fees which may be required in order to use the Oklahoma City
13 Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing agreement shall
14 provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon of not
15 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

16 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
18 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
19 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
20 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

21 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
22 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
23 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
24 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the

1 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
2 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
3 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
4 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

5 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
7 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
8 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
9 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
10 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
11 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
12 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
13 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
14 Section 1104.10 of this title;

15 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
16 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
17 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
18 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
19 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
20 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
21 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
22 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
23 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

1 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
2 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
3 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
4 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
5 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
6 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
7 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
8 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
9 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
10 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

11 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plate -
12 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
13 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
14 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
15 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
16 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
17 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
18 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
19 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
20 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
21 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
22 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
23 plate issued;

24

1 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
3 the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be designed
4 in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Association. As
5 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
6 deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving Fund created in
7 Section 1104.12 of this title;

8 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
9 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
10 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
11 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
12 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
13 letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license
14 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
15 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
16 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

17 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
18 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
19 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
20 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,
21 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
22 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this
23 title;
24

1 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
2 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
3 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
4 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be

23 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Music
24 Hall of Fame Inc. and issued to any member of the organization

1 wishing to demonstrate support. The Tax Commission shall be
2 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma
3 Music Hall of Fame Inc. for any licensing fees which may be required
4 in order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing
5 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Music Hall of
6 Fame Inc. of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
7 plate issued. The plates shall incorporate a numbering system
8 agreed upon by the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame Inc. and the Tax
9 Commission. Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this
10 section, the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame Inc. License Plate is
11 hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2019;

12 82. Techlahoma Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be
13 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
14 Techlahoma Foundation. The license plate shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Techlahoma Foundation. The plate shall be
16 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
17 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. The Tax
18 Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement
19 with the Techlahoma Foundation for any licensing fees, which may be
20 required in order to use the association's logo or design. The
21 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Techlahoma
22 Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
23 plate issued;

1 83. Bethany Public Schools Foundation License Plate - such
2 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
3 for the Bethany Public Schools Foundation. The license plates shall
4 be designed in consultation with the administration of the Bethany
5 Public Schools Foundation. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be
6 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Bethany
7 Public Schools Foundation for any licensing fees which may be
8 required in order to use the Foundation's logo or design. The
9 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Bethany
10 Public Schools Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00)
11 for each license plate issued;

12 84. Cystic Fibrosis Foundation License Plate - such plates
13 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
14 Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in
15 consultation with the administration of the Cystic Fibrosis
16 Foundation. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to
17 enter into a licensing agreement with the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation
18 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
19 Foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
20 for a payment to the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation of not more than
21 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

22 85. Down Syndrome Association of Central Oklahoma License Plate
23 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
24 demonstrate support for the Down Syndrome Association of Central

1 Oklahoma. Such plates shall be designed in consultation with the
2 Association. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
3 collected shall be deposited in the Down Syndrome Association of
4 Central Oklahoma License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section
5 1104.30 of this title;

6 86. Elk City Education Foundation License Plate - such plates
7 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
8 support for the Elk City Education Foundation. Such plates shall be
9 designed in consultation with the Foundation. As provided in this
10 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
11 Elk City Education Foundation License Plate Revolving Fund created
12 in Section 1104.31 of this title;

13 87. A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma (ABATE)
14 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
15 person wishing to provide financial support for ABATE of Oklahoma.
16 Such plates shall be designed in consultation with ABATE of
17 Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
18 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
19 as for personalized plates. The license plate for a motorcycle may
20 be of similar design as space permits or a new design in order to
21 meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The
22 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
23 licensing agreement with ABATE of Oklahoma for any licensing fees
24 which may be required in order to use the ABATE of Oklahoma logo or

1 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
2 ABATE of Oklahoma of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
3 license plate issued;

4 88. Downed Bikers Association License Plate - such plates shall
5 be designed for a vehicle or motorcycle in any combination of
6 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
7 personalized plates, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
8 support for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
9 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
10 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
11 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
12 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
13 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
14 official logo or design of the organization. The license plate for
15 a motorcycle may be of similar design as space permits or a new
16 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle
17 license plate. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter into a
18 licensing agreement with the Downed Bikers Association for any
19 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
20 organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall
21 provide for a payment to the Downed Bikers Association of not more
22 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate;

23 89. Eagle Scout License Plate - Such plates shall be designed
24 to demonstrate support for Eagle Scouts and shall include the Eagle

1 Scout logo. Plates may be issued to any person who can show proof
2 of having obtained the rank of Eagle Scout. The Oklahoma Tax
3 Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement
4 with the various Oklahoma local councils for any licensing fees
5 which may be required in order to use the applicable logo or design.
6 The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not more than
7 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued to the
8 specific Oklahoma local area Council designated by the applicant;

9 90. Extraordinary Educators License Plate - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any person wishing to provide financial
11 support for common education in Oklahoma. Such plates shall be
12 designed in consultation with the State Department of Education.
13 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
14 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
15 personalized plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the
16 fee collected shall be deposited in the Extraordinary Educators
17 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.32 of this
18 title;

19 91. Former Oklahoma Legislator License Plate - such plates
20 shall be designed and issued to any person who previously served as
21 a member of the Oklahoma House of Representatives or Oklahoma State
22 Senate. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
23 the Oklahoma Historical Society. As provided in this section, an
24 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma

1 Historical Society Capital Improvement and Operations Revolving Fund
2 created in Section 1.10a of Title 53 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The
3 Tax Commission shall create and maintain a list of former members of
4 the Oklahoma House of Representatives and Oklahoma State Senate
5 eligible to be issued such plates; provided, that no former member
6 of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and Oklahoma State Senate
7 shall be eligible to possess more than two of such plates at any one
8 time. The Tax Commission shall confer as needed with the Chief
9 Clerk of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Secretary of
10 the Oklahoma State Senate to confirm that such list is complete and
11 accurate;

12 92. Monarch Butterfly License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
14 the operations of the Nature Conservancy of Oklahoma. Such plates
15 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
16 Nature Conservancy. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
17 into a licensing agreement with the Nature Conservancy of Oklahoma
18 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
19 foundation's logo or design. The plates shall be issued to any
20 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
21 maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. The licensing
22 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Nature Conservancy of
23 Oklahoma of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
24 plate issued;

1 93. Oklahoma Tennis Foundation License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation. The license plates
4 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Tennis
5 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
6 licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation for any
7 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
8 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
9 for a payment to the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation of not more than
10 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

11 94. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plate - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
13 for the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation. The license plates
14 shall be designed in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars
15 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
16 licensing agreement with the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation for
17 any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
18 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
19 for a payment to the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation of not more
20 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

21 95. Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization License Plate - such
22 plates shall be designed and issued to any female veteran of any
23 branch of the United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate
24 support for the Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization. The license

plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

96. FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) License Plate - such plates shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for FIRST Robotics Programs. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the administration of FIRST. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with FIRST for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the FIRST logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to FIRST of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

97. Pittsburg State University License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Pittsburg State University. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with Pittsburg State University. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with Pittsburg State University for any licensing fees

1 which may be required in order to use the school foundation's logo
2 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
3 the Pittsburg State University of not more than Twenty Dollars
4 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; ~~and~~

5 98. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates
6 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the
7 Historic Greenwood District Juneteenth Festival held in the Historic
8 Greenwood District in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued
9 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
10 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
11 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Black Wall Street
12 Chamber of Commerce. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee
13 collected shall be deposited in the Historic Greenwood
14 District/Juneteenth Festival Revolving Fund established in Section 5
15 ~~of this act~~ 2368.32 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Two
16 Dollars (\$2.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
17 Public School Classroom Support Revolving Fund, for expenditure as

19 99. Bison License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
20 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the

23 Conservancy. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
24 licensing agreement with the Nature Conservancy of Oklahoma for any

2 foundation's logo or design. The plates shall be issued to any
3 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
4 maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. The licensing

17 be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
18 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
19 Registration Act; and

20 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
21 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

23 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
24 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
