An Act relating to state government; directing certain agencies who contract with certain entities to require an annual report to be submitted to the agency; stating contents of the report; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10004 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any state agency which contracts with an outside entity to provide payments to individuals using a card-based disbursement system shall require the entity, as part of the contract, to submit an annual report to the contracting agency. The report shall disclose the measures the entity takes to protect the privacy of the recipient, any data-sharing agreements to which the entity is a party, and the amount of fees the entity has charged to the recipient of the payments.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
