9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
10	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 64, O.S.L.
11	2018, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 478, O.S.L. 2019 (2 O.S.
12	Supp. 2019, Section 3-403), is amended to read as follows:
13	Section 3-403. A. A licensee is authorized to:
14	1. Engage in the growth and cultivation of industrial hemp for
15	agricultural plant research purposes; and
16	2. Upon approval by the United States Department of Agriculture
17	of the Oklahoma Industrial Hemp Program, engage in the growth,
18	cultivation, handling or processing of industrial hemp.
19	B. The activities performed under the Oklahoma Industrial Hemp
20	Program shall not subject the persons participating in the program
21	to criminal liability under the Uniform Controlled Dangerous
22	Substances Act. The exemption from criminal liability provided for
23	in this subsection is a limited exemption that shall be strictly
24
