15	Section 988.22. A. Any offender ordered to participate in the
16	local community sentencing system shall be advised of the conditions
17	of the specific program or service to which he or she is assigned.
18	B. Upon completion of any court-ordered provision, pursuant to
19	the Oklahoma Community Sentencing Act, the administrator of the
20	local system supervising agency or contracted provider shall file a
21	statement with the court defining the provision which has been
22	successfully completed. When all court-ordered provisions have been
23	successfully completed the defendant shall be deemed to have
24	completed the community punishment.
