10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:		
11	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified		
12	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 175.18a of Title 60, unless		
13	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:		
14	A. A successor trustee may file with the county clerk an		
15	Affidavit of Successor Trustee, which shall state the following with		
16	respect to the trust:		
17	1. The full legal name and date of the trust;		
18	2. The name, address and date of death of the decedent grantor;		
19	3. The name and address of the successor trustee;		
20	4. A full legal description of the real property and the		
21	probable value of the personal property of the decedent grantor		
22	within the trust;

5. A date, time and place for presentation of creditor claims which shall be no less than forty-five (45) days from the filing thereof;

- 6. That the person receiving the Affidavit or any interested party may file claims at any time before the date set pursuant to paragraph 5 of this subsection and send a copy to the successor trustee or that person will be deemed to have waived any claim against trust property;
- 7. That if a claim is filed before the date set pursuant to paragraph 5 of this subsection, the successor trustee must settle the claim before any distributions may be made to beneficiaries; and
- 8. The claim of any creditor will be barred unless the claim is presented to the successor trustee no more than forty-five (45) days following the filing of the Affidavit of Successor Trustee.
- B. Within ten (10) days of the filing of the Affidavit of Successor Trustee, the Successor Trustee shall cause the Affidavit to be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper that is authorized by law to publish legal notices and that is published in the county where the Affidavit is filed. If no newspaper authorized by law to publish legal notices is published in the county, the Affidavit shall be posted in three public places in the county, one of which shall be the county courthouse. Within ten (10) days of the filing of the Affidavit, the Affidavit shall be mailed to creditors of the decedent grantor as provided in Sections

331 and 331.1 of Title 58 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Within ten (10) days of the filing of the Affidavit, the Affidavit shall be mailed to all persons interested in the trust at their respective last-known addresses.

C. All claims arising upon contracts entered into prior to the decedent grantor's death, whether the same be due, not due or contingent, must be presented on or before the presentment date as provided in the Affidavit of Successor Trustee, and any claim not so presented is barred forever; provided, however, that when it is made to appear by the affidavit of the claimant, to the satisfaction of the judge of the district court, as duly noted on the claim, that the claimant had no notice by reason of being out of the state and that a copy of the notice to creditors was not mailed to the claimant, the claim may be presented at any time before final distribution is made; provided, further, that nothing in this section, nor in this chapter contained, shall be construed to prohibit the right or limit the time of foreclosure of mortgages upon real property of decedent grantors, but every such mortgage may be foreclosed within the time and in the mode prescribed in civil procedure, except that no balance of the debt secured by such mortgage remaining unpaid after foreclosure shall be a claim against the trust or trustee, unless such debt was presented as required by this title.
