A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-104.10 of Title 70, unless 14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 15 The Imagination Library Revolving Fund created pursuant to 16 Section 2 of this act shall be used to promote and foster the 17 development of the Oklahoma Imagination Library Program, which shall 18 be a statewide program for encouraging pre-school children to read 19 by providing age-appropriate books to children at their homes from 20 birth to age 5 on a monthly basis. 21 The State Department of Education shall: 22 В. 1. Manage the daily operations of the Oklahoma Imagination 23 Library Program and provide oversight of the Imagination Library 24

Revolving Fund including but not limited to establishing countybased programs in all seventy-seven counties and advancing and
strengthening the programs to ensure enrollment growth;

- 2. Develop, promote and coordinate a public awareness program to make donors aware of the opportunity to donate to the Imagination Library Revolving Fund; and
- 3. Develop, promote and coordinate a public awareness program to make the public aware of the opportunity to register children to receive age-appropriate books on a monthly basis. To receive books on a monthly basis, a child shall be under the age of 5 and shall have an Oklahoma residence.
- C. The State Department of Education may establish a volunteer advisory committee to assist with implementing the provisions of paragraphs 2 and 3 of subsection B of this section.
- D. The State Department of Education is authorized to retain up to ten percent (10%) of the funds appropriated, gifted, granted, donated or bequested to the Imagination Library Revolving Fund for administrative and operating expenses related to implementation of the Oklahoma Imagination Library Program.
- E. The State Department of Education shall submit a report by July 1, 2021, and each July 1 thereafter to the chair of the Senate Education Committee and the chair of the House of Representatives Common Education Committee detailing the status of implementing the Oklahoma Imagination Library Program.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-104.11 of Title 70, unless 3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund 4 5 for the State Department of Education to be designated the "Imagination Library Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a 6 7 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the State Department of Education 9 from appropriations, gifts, grants, donations and bequests. All 10 monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated 11 and may be budgeted and expended by the State Department of 12 Education for the purpose of implementing the provisions of Section 1 of this act. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon 13 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as 14 15 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and 16 Enterprise Services for approval and payment. SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020. 17 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 21
