Supp. 2019, Section 1948), is amended to read as follows: 16 Section 1948. All licensed behavioral practitioners licensed 17 pursuant to the Licensed Behavioral Practitioner Act shall be 18 required to satisfactorily complete ten (10) hours of continuing 19 education credits annually. The State Board of Behavioral Health 20 Licensure shall provide forms and require verification of such 21 credits. Such credits shall be earned from courses on empirically 22 validated procedures, taught by instructors certified by the North 23 24

3	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
