10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
11	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2001.1 of Title 12, unless there
13	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
14	A. No person asserting a cause of action in a court of this
15	state shall have standing to maintain a cause of action unless he or
16	she can demonstrate:
17	1. A concrete and particularized injury-in-fact that is not
18	conjectural or hypothetical in nature;
19	2. The injury is fairly traceable to the actions that are the
20	subject of the suit; and
21	3. The injury will be redressed by a favorable decision of the
22	court.
23	B. No person may assert a cause of action in a court of this

state based on a general grievance of the public at large or to

vindicate the rights of other individuals, but rather must
demonstrate an injury that is personal to the party asserting the
cause of action.
C. The person invoking the jurisdiction of a court over a cause
of action shall carry the burden to establish proper standing to
maintain such cause of action and shall maintain such standing
throughout the proceedings of the court.
SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
