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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5028.2 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall initiate requests for proposals for a pilot program to examine the feasibility of transforming the current Medicaid program from a fee-for-service payment model to a value-based payment model utilizing a provider-led accountable care organization. The pilot program shall begin no later than January 1, 2022.

B. The pilot program implemented by the accountable care organization shall contain, but not be limited to, the following components:

1. Value-based purchasing;
2. Quality measurements;

1        3. Data-sharing and integration;

2        4. Care management;

3        5. Provider and community collaboration; and

4        6. Preservation of the Supplemental Hospital Offset Payment

6        C. The accountable care organization shall be headquartered in  
7 this state and shall be owned by a resident of this state.

8        D. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate  
9 rules to implement the provisions of this act.

10       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
