7	An Act relating to hotels; amending 63 O.S. 2011,
8	Section 1-1201, which relates to licenses; modifying definition; updating statutory language; providing
9	gender neutral language; and declaring an emergency.

11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-1201, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 1-1201. $\frac{\text{(a)}}{\text{A.}}$ It shall be unlawful for any person to
15	operate or maintain a hotel unless he <u>or she</u> shall have first
16	obtained, and holds, a license issued for such purpose by the State
17	Commissioner of Health. Unless otherwise provided by rule by the
18	State Board of Health Commissioner, each such license shall expire
19	on the 30th day of June next following its issuance, and the
20	Commissioner shall charge and collect therefor an annual fee to be
21	fixed by the <del>Board of Health</del> <u>Commissioner</u> . The term "hotel" as used
22	in this section shall mean and include any hotel, motel, tourist
23	court, apartment house, rooming house, or other place where sleeping
24	accommodations are furnished, or offered, for pay for transient

1	guests, if <del>four</del> <u>seven</u> or more rooms are available therein for
2	transient guests. This section shall apply to the operation of a
3	hotel by a state board.
4	(b) B. The <del>State Board of Health</del> <u>Commissioner</u> may adopt
5	reasonable standards, rules and regulations for hotels as to the
6	following: buildings and appurtenances thereto, including plumbing,
7	ventilation and lighting; construction, cleanliness and bactericidal
8	treatment of equipment and utensils; cleanliness and hygiene of
9	personnel; toilet facilities; disposal of wastes; water supply; and
10	any other items deemed necessary to safeguard the health, comfort
11	and safety of guests accommodated therein.
12	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14	declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take
15	effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
