10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-527, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Section 1-527. Any physician who makes a diagnosis or treats a
14	case of a sexually transmitted infection (STI), and every
15	superintendent or manager of a hospital, dispensary or charitable or
16	penal institution in which there is a case of an STI, shall report
17	such case immediately, in writing, to or electronically:
18	1. To the director or designee of the city-county health
19	department, if in Oklahoma County or Tulsa County, who shall, in
20	turn, report such case to the State Commissioner of Health; or
21	2. Directly to the State Commissioner of Health, or the local
22	health officer if not in Oklahoma County or Tulsa County,
23	in the same manner as other communicable diseases are reported, in
24	forms to be prescribed and furnished by the Commissioner.

1	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
