SENATE BILL NO. 271

[public finance - requirements for disclosure -
exception - codification - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.42.1 of Title 62, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Except as provided in subsection C of this section, all agencies shall make an annual disclosure pursuant to a separate written report and information available through a website maintained by or on behalf of the entity of all federal funds under the control of the entity and the programs for which the federal funds are used by distinct expenditure categories and shall identify the priority or rank of the federal funds in descending order with the funding source the agency relies on to the greatest extent listed first and the funding source the agency relies on to the least extent listed last. The information required by this subsection shall include, but shall not be limited to:

1 1. A description of any action required to be taken by the
2 state government entity as a condition for the receipt or continued
3 receipt of federal funds;

4 2. A description of any action prohibited to be taken by the
5 state government entity as a condition for the receipt or continued
6 receipt of federal funds;

7 3. A description of any action required to be taken by any
8 individual or lawfully recognized business entity or other entity as
9 a condition for the benefits purported to be conferred on the
10 individual or other legal entity as a result of the use of the
11 federal funds; and

12 4. A description of any action prohibited to be taken by any
13 individual or lawfully recognized business entity or other entity as
14 a condition for the benefits purported to be conferred on the
15 individual or other legal entity as a result of the use of the
16 federal funds.

17 B. Every entity subject to the requirements of this section
18 shall make an annual disclosure, either pursuant to a separate
19 written report, information available through a website maintained
20 by or on behalf of the entity or both, of the federal funds for
21 which the agency must incur costs to implement and shall provide
22 such information in descending order with the most costly federal
23 funds listed first and the least costly federal funds listed last.

1 C. Any agency receiving and administering federal funds that
2 require the receiving agency to maintain any level of security
3 clearance in order to administer those funds shall be exempt from
4 the provisions of this section.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
