14	Section 3102.5. <u>A.</u> No person shall be authorized under Section
15	$\frac{2}{2}$ 3102.4 of this act title to make health care decisions for a
16	patient if that person:
17	1. Has been convicted of, pled guilty to, or pled no contest to
18	any violation of Section 843.1, 843.2, 843.4 or 843.5 of Title 21 of
19	the Oklahoma Statutes;
20	2. Has been found to have committed abuse, verbal abuse or
21	exploitation, as these terms are defined in Section 10-103 of Title
22	43A of the Oklahoma Statutes, by a final State Department of Health
23	or Department of Human Services investigative finding or by an
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1 administrative law judge finding, unless that finding has been
2 overturned through judicial review; or

3 3. Has been criminally charged as described in subsection B of
4 Section 10-110.1 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes, unless the
5 person has been acquitted or those charges have been finally
6 dismissed.

7	B. No health care provider or health care entity shall be
8	liable for following in good faith the instructions of a person
9	otherwise authorized to make health care decisions for a patient
10	pursuant to Section 3102.4 of this title, but whom the health care
11	provider or health care entity does not know or have reason to know
12	is disqualified from exercising such authority by subsection A of
13	this section.
