19	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 229, O.S.L.
20	2017, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 387, O.S.L. 2017 (72 O.S.
21	Supp. 2018, Section 421), is amended to read as follows:
22	Section 421. A. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs
23	shall create and maintain a registry of all veterans in this state
24	by January 1, 2020, which shall be titled the "Oklahoma Veterans

1 <u>Registry</u>". The registry shall include the following information 2 regarding the veteran:

3 1. Name;

4 2. Military ranking rank and branch of service;

5 3. Dates of service;

6 4. Documentation Percentage of one hundred percent (100%)
7 service-disability, service-connected disability, if applicable; and
8 5. Date of death and place of burial interment, if applicable;
9 and

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6. Name of the veteran's spouse, if applicable.

11 в. As a component of the veterans registry created pursuant to 12 subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall designate those veterans within the registry as one 13 hundred percent (100%) service-disabled Oklahoma veterans, if 14 15 applicable. The registry designation shall also be maintained as a separate list within the registry for all one hundred percent (100%) 16 service-disabled Oklahoma veterans. The Department shall be 17 responsible for verification of all information provided through the 18 registry and shall verify veteran service disability status at least 19 once every four (4) years. 20

C. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall may

 D. For purposes of this section, "veteran" means a person who

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SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-317b of Title 63, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The Commissioner of the State Department of Health shall 11 authorize the regular transmission of a list to the Oklahoma 12 Department of Veterans Affairs of all registered deaths of residents 13 of this state that have occurred within the state and who are indicated to be a veteran on the death record. The Oklahoma 14 Department of Veterans Affairs shall use the transmitted list to 15 identify Oklahoma veterans, as defined in Section 2 of Title 72 of 16 17 the Oklahoma Statutes, for purposes of populating, updating and maintaining the veterans registry established in Section 421 of 18 Title 72 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The Social Security Number of an 19 individual veteran shall not be released as a part of the registry. 20 The State Department of Health shall transmit to the Oklahoma 21 Department of Veterans Affairs the following: 22

23 1. Veteran's name;

24 2. Social Security Number;
