As used in this paragraph, "physician" means a person 19 holding a valid license to practice medicine and surgery, 20 osteopathic medicine, podiatric medicine, dentistry, chiropractic or 21 optometry, pursuant to the state licensing provisions of Title 59 of 22 the Oklahoma Statutes. As used in this section, "hospital" shall be 23
