8	which relates to exemptions; providing exemptions; providing requirements for exemptions; requiring		
9	registration with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; updating statutory		
10	references; and providing an effective date.		
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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:		
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 6-265, is		
15	amended to read as follows:		
16	Section 6-265. A. The <u>State</u> Board <u>of Agriculture</u> shall, by		
17	regulation and under such conditions, including requirements, as to		
18	sanitary standards, practices, and procedures as it may prescribe,		
19	exempt from specific provisions of this act the Oklahoma Poultry		
20	Products Inspection Act with respect to processing of poultry or		
21	poultry products solely for intrastate commerce and distribution of		
22	poultry or poultry products only in such commerce:		
23	1. for such period of time as the Board determines that it		
24	would be impracticable to provide inspection and the exemption will		

aid in the effective administration of this act, any person engaged in the processing of poultry or poultry products and the poultry or poultry products processed by such person; provided, that, no such exemption shall continue in effect more than one hundred twenty (120) days after enactment of this act;

2. persons Persons slaughtering, processing, or otherwise handling poultry or poultry products which have been or are to be processed as required by recognized religious dietary laws, to the extent that the Board determines necessary to avoid conflict with such requirements while still effectuating the purposes of this act the Oklahoma Poultry Products Inspection Act;

3. the 2. The slaughtering by any person of poultry of his or her own raising, and the processing by him or her and transportation of the poultry products exclusively for use by him or her and members of his or her household and his or her nonpaying guests and employees; provided that such poultry products when so distributed, bear, in lieu of labeling that would otherwise be required, the producer's name and address and the statement "Exempted - P.L. 90-492" and such poultry products are not otherwise misbranded;

4. the 3. The custom slaughter by any person of poultry delivered by the owner thereof for such slaughter, and the processing by such slaughterer and transportation of the poultry products exclusively for use, in the household of such owner, by him

or her and members of his or her household and his or her nonpaying guests and employees; provided, that.

- a. such custom slaughterer does not engage in the business of buying or selling any poultry products capable of use as human food, and
- b. such poultry products when so distributed, bear, in lieu of labeling that would otherwise be required, the producer's name and address and the statement "Not For Sale" and such poultry products are not otherwise misbranded;
- 5. operations 4. Operations of types traditionally and usually conducted at retail stores and restaurants, when conducted at any retail store or restaurant or similar retail-type establishment for sale in normal retail quantities or service of such articles to consumers at such establishments, if no poultry or poultry products are processed at the establishment for distribution within this state or otherwise subject to inspection under the Federal Poultry Products Inspection Act;
- 5. The slaughtering of sound and healthy poultry and processing of poultry products therefrom in this state by any poultry producer on the producer's own premises with respect to poultry raised on the producer's premises, and the distribution by any person solely within this state of the poultry products derived from such operations; provided that:

2		provisions of this act, such poultry is slaughtered
3		and otherwise processed and handled under such

5		in the preparation of poultry products that are sound,

12	<u>C.</u>	such producer and distributor do not engage in the
13		current calendar year in the business of buying or
14		selling any poultry or poultry products other than as
15		specified in paragraphs 6 and 7 of this subsection,
16		<u>and</u>
17	<u>d.</u>	neither such producer nor distributor slaughters or
18		processes the products of more poultry than allowed by
19		subsection B of this section;
20	6. The s	laughtering of sound and healthy poultry or the
21	processing of	poultry products of such poultry in this state by any
22	poultry produ	cer or other person for distribution by them solely
23	within this s	tate directly to household consumers, restaurants,
24	hotels and bo	ardinghouses for use in their own dining rooms, or in

1	the preparati	on of meals for sales direct to consumers; provided
2	that:	
3	<u>a.</u>	in lieu of complying with all the adulteration
4		provisions of this act, such poultry is slaughtered
5		and otherwise processed and handled under such
6		sanitary standards, practices and procedures as result
7		in the preparation of poultry products that are sound,
8		clean and fit for human food when distributed by such
9		processor,
10	<u>b.</u>	such poultry products when so distributed, bear, in
11		lieu of labeling that would otherwise be required, the
12		processor's name and address and the statement
13		"Exempted - P.L. 90-492" and such poultry products are
14		not otherwise misbranded,
15	<u>C.</u>	such processor does not engage in the current calendar
16		year in the business of buying or selling any poultry
17		or poultry products other than as specified in
18		paragraphs 6 and 7 of this subsection, and
19	<u>d.</u>	such processor does not exceed the volume limitation
20		prescribed in subsection B of this section; and
21	7. The $6$	operations and products of small enterprises including
22	poultry produ	icers, not exempted under paragraphs 1 through 6 of this
23	subsection th	nat are engaged in this state in slaughtering or cutting
24		

1 up poultry for distribution as carcasses or parts thereof solely for 2 distribution within this state; provided that: 3 such poultry is sound and healthy when slaughtered and a. is slaughtered or cut up and handled under such 4 5 sanitary standards, practices and procedures as result in the preparation of poultry products that are not 6 adulterated when so distributed, and 7 when so distributed, such poultry products are not 8 b. 9 misbranded, except that the official inspection legend shall not be used. 10 11 No person qualifies for any exemption specified in 12 paragraphs 5, 6 and 7 of subsection A of this section if, in the current calendar year, such person: 13 1. Slaughters or processes the products of more than twenty 14 15 thousand (20,000) poultry; or 16 2. Slaughters or processes poultry products at a facility used for slaughtering or processing poultry products by any other person, 17 except when the Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry grants 18 such exemption after determining, upon review of a person's 19

22 <u>C.</u> The provisions of this act shall not apply to poultry
23 producers with respect to poultry of their own raising on their own
24 farms if

application, that such an exemption will not impair effectuating the

9	Any person performing on-farm slaughter of poultry pursuant to
10	this section shall:
11	1. Register with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food,

13	2. Follow basic sanitary standards, practices and procedures
14	pursuant to 9 C.F.R. Sections 416.2 through 416.5; and
15	3. Make the exempt slaughter facility available for review of
16	sanitary requirements twice per year by the Department or an
17	authorized agent of the Board.
18	$rac{ extsf{C.}}{ extsf{D.}}$ The adulteration and misbranding provisions of this act,
19	other than the requirement of the inspection legend, shall apply to
20	articles which are exempted from inspection under this section.
21	$rac{ extsf{D.}}{ extsf{E.}}$ The Board may by order suspend or terminate any exemption
22	with respect to any person whenever it finds that such action will
23	aid in effectuating the purposes of <del>this act</del> the Oklahoma Poultry

Products Inspection Act.

1	F. Producers using the exemptions provided in this act shall
2	assume all liability.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
