17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4432 of Title 70, unless there
19	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. There is hereby created until July 1, 2020, a task force to

services" shall mean the duties of any college employee who has
responsibility for administrative functions including but not
limited to human resources, purchasing, accounting and information
technology.

B. The task force shall be comprised of five (5) members to be7 appointed as follows:

8 1. One member who represents the business community, appointed9 by the Governor;

One member who represents a two-year college, appointed by
the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;

One member who represents a comprehensive university,
appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

14 4. The Chancellor of Higher Education or a designee; and

15 5. The Secretary of Education or a designee.

16 The chair of the task force shall be the Secretary of Education 17 or his or her designee.

18 C. Appointments to the task force shall be made within thirty 19 (30) days after the effective date of this act. The task force 20 shall conduct an organizational meeting not later than August 31, 21 2019.

D. A quorum of the task force shall be required to approve any final action of the task force. For purposes of this section, three members shall constitute a quorum.
