12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 359, O.S.L.
13	2017 (74 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 150.9.1), is amended to read as
14	follows:
15	Section 150.9.1. The Oklahoma Tax Commission, Oklahoma
16	Department of Human Services and Oklahoma Employment Security
17	Commission shall be authorized to require agency employees and the
18	employees of agency contractors in positions that have access to
19	Federal Tax Information and data to supply all information and
20	documentation required in order to be subjected to a criminal
21	history search by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, as
22	well as be fingerprinted for submission of the fingerprints through
23	the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to the Federal Bureau of
24	Investigation for a national criminal history check. The applicable

employer-agency submitting agency shall be the recipient of the results of the record check. In accordance with Section 150.9 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, this includes a national criminal record with a fingerprint analysis. SECTION 2.
