12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-603, is

14	Section 3-603. A. The Board of Mental Health and Substance
15	Abuse Services shall approve a standard medication fee for persons
16	participating in an opioid substitution treatment program which
17	accepts Medicare or Medicaid. An opioid substitution treatment
18	program which does not accept either Medicare or Medicaid may assess
19	a medication fee on persons participating in the opioid substitution
20	treatment program in an amount determined by the opioid substitution
21	treatment program.
22	B. A person participating in an opioid substitution treatment
23	program shall be terminated from the program if the person fails to
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1	participate in counseling sessions or if the person fails to adhere
2	to the program's guidelines as promulgated by the Board.
3	C. The Board is authorized to promulgate such rules as are
4	necessary to implement this act.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
