12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-169 of Title 70, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. The State Board of Education shall issue a request for  
17 proposals on or before December 31, 2019, for the selection of a  
18 statewide student information system.

19 B. The Board shall adopt a statewide student information system  
20 from the selected proposals that were submitted pursuant to  
21 subsection A of this section.

22 C. The statewide student information system selected pursuant  
23 to this section shall be administered on a pilot program basis for  
24 two (2) years. The Board shall develop a structure to incentivize

1 school districts to participate in the pilot program; however,  
2 participation shall not be required. As part of the pilot program,  
3 the Board shall study, develop and establish policies for data  
4 inventory and data elements including the definition of data fields  
5 for the student information system.

6 D. Based on the success of the pilot program, the Board may  
7 implement the student information system on a statewide basis, at  
8 which time participation shall be required for all school districts  
9 in the state. The Board may establish a fee for school district  
10 participation in the statewide student information system.

11 ~~SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.~~

12 ~~SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation~~  
13 ~~of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby~~  
14 ~~declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and~~  
15 ~~be in full force from and after its passage and approval.~~
