9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 427 of Title 63, unless there is
12 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 All marijuana advertising and labels of usable marijuana and
14 marijuana products sold in this state shall not contain any
15 statement or illustration that:

16 1. Is false or misleading;

17 2. Promotes overconsumption;

18 3. Represents that the use of marijuana has curative or
19 therapeutic effects; or

20 4. Depicts a child or other person under legal age to consume
21 marijuana, or includes:

22 a. objects such as toys, cartoon or other characters,
23 which suggest the presence of a child, or any other
24 depiction designed in any manner to be especially

1 appealing to children or other persons under legal age
2 to consume marijuana, or

3 b. any manner or design that would be especially
4 appealing to children or other persons under eighteen
5 (18) years of age.

6 ~~SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation~~
7 ~~of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby~~
8 ~~declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and~~
9 ~~be in full force from and after its passage and approval.~~
