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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 427 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. All medical marijuana and medical marijuana products shall be packaged in child resistant packages as required by the federal Poison Prevention Packaging Act of 1970.

B. Medical marijuana packaging shall not bear a reasonable resemblance to any commercially available product. Medical marijuana products shall be packaged to minimize appeal to children and shall not depict shapes, images, text or designs appealing to children. Medical marijuana product packages shall:

1. Be plain;

2. Be designed to maximize the shelf life of contained medical marijuana products;

3. Be tamper-evident;

1 4. Be child proof;

2 5. Protect the product from contamination and shall not impart
3 any toxic or deleterious substance to the product;

4 6. Be opaque; and

5 7. Not depict any images or commercial logos.
