9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
10	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 427 of Title 63, unless there is
12	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
13	A. All medical marijuana and medical marijuana products shall
14	be packaged in child resistant packages as required by the federal
15	Poison Prevention Packaging Act of 1970.
16	B. Medical marijuana packaging shall not bear a reasonable
17	resemblance to any commercially available product. Medical
18	marijuana products shall be packaged to minimize appeal to children
19	and shall not depict shapes, images, text or designs appealing to
20	children. Medical marijuana product packages shall:
21	1. Be plain;
22	2. Be designed to maximize the shelf life of contained medical
23	marijuana products;

3. Be tamper-evident;
