An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 802, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 48, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 802), which relates to commercial driver training; requiring content related to human trafficking be included in course of study; requiring regular review and updating of content; requiring certain collaboration; requiring certain publication in certain manner; updating statutory reference; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 802, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 48, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 802), is amended to read as follows:

Section 802. A. The Commissioner shall adopt and prescribe such regulations concerning the administration and enforcement of ~~this act~~ Section 801 et seq. of this title as are necessary to carry out the intent of this act and to protect the public. The Commissioner or his authorized representative shall inspect the

1 school facilities and equipment of applicants and licensees and
2 examine applicants for instructor's licenses.

3 B. The Commissioner shall administer and enforce the provisions
4 of this act, and may call upon the State Superintendent of Public
5 Instruction for assistance in developing and formulating appropriate
6 regulations.

7 C. 1. The Commissioner may require that the course of study
8 for training students for Class A, B or C commercial licenses shall
9 include training on the recognition, prevention and reporting of
10 human trafficking. If required, the Commissioner shall regularly
11 review and update the training to take into account changes and
12 trends in human trafficking. ~~To establish the content of training,~~

18 2. The Commissioner ~~shall publish content~~ may identify and
19 establish industry specific materials for use in the instruction
