8 **[ Commission for Rehabilitation Services - powers and**  
9 **duties of the Commission for Rehabilitation Services**  
10 **- use of gifts - effective date ]**

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 166.5, as  
14 amended by Section 838, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp.  
15 2018, Section 166.5), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 166.5. A. The Commission for Rehabilitation Services  
17 shall have the powers and duties to:

18 1. Adopt bylaws and promulgate rules for the regulation of its  
19 affairs and the conduct of its business;

20 2. Formulate policies and adopt rules for the effective  
21 administration of the duties of the State Department of  
22 Rehabilitation Services;

23 3. Adopt an official seal;

24 4. Establish an office;

1           5. Sue and to be sued, subject to the provisions of The  
2 Governmental Tort Claims Act;

3           6. Make and enter into all contracts necessary or incidental to  
4 the performance of its duties and the execution of its powers;

5           7. Purchase or lease equipment, furniture, materials and  
6 supplies, and incur such other expenses as may be necessary to  
7 maintain and operate the Commission and the State Department of  
8 Rehabilitation Services, or to discharge its duties and  
9 responsibilities or to make any of its powers effective;

10          8. Acquire by purchase, lease, gift, solicitation of gift or by  
11 any other manner, and to maintain, use and operate or to contract  
12 for the maintenance, use and operation of or lease of any and all  
13 property of any kind, real, personal or mixed or any interest  
14 therein unless otherwise provided by ~~this act~~ Section 166.1 et seq.  
15 of this title; provided that, all contracts for real property shall  
16 be subject to the provisions of Section 63 of this title;

17          9. Appoint such officers, agents and employees as it deems  
18 necessary to operate and maintain the Commission and to prescribe  
19 their duties and to fix their compensation;

20          10. Perform such other acts as shall be necessary for the  
21 accomplishment of the purposes of ~~Chapter 5A~~ Section 166.1 et seq.  
22 of this title; and  
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1 11. Serve as trustee for the trust created in subsection B of  
2 this section for the benefit of the Oklahoma School for the Blind  
3 and the Oklahoma School for the Deaf.

4 B. 1. The Commission for Rehabilitation Services is hereby  
5 authorized and directed to create a trust into which all real  
6 property held by the Commission for the benefit of the Oklahoma  
7 School for the Blind and the Oklahoma School for the Deaf shall be  
8 transferred.

9 2. The property placed in trust:

10 a. shall be held for the sole benefit of the Oklahoma  
11 School for the Blind and the Oklahoma School for the  
12 Deaf,

13 b. if not needed for use by the schools, may be leased or  
14 rented to others and all income received from such  
15 leases or rentals shall be payable to the Commission  
16 and deposited in the Rehabilitation Services  
17 Disbursing Fund for use by the Commission to fulfill  
18 the purposes of the Oklahoma School for the Blind and  
19 the Oklahoma School for the Deaf, and

20 c. may be sold if the commissioners, acting as trustees,  
21 determine that the sale is in the best interest of the  
22 Oklahoma School for the Blind or the Oklahoma School  
23 for the Deaf. The proceeds from the sale of the  
24 property shall be held in the trust corpus and shall

1 be invested by the State Treasurer. Income derived  
2 from the corpus shall be used by the Commission for  
3 the purposes of the Oklahoma School for the Blind and  
4 the Oklahoma School for the Deaf.

5 3. The corpus of the trust may be disbursed only upon  
6 legislative approval.

7 4. The trust may be dissolved only upon legislative approval.

8 C. Upon the creation of the trust authorized in subsection B of  
9 this section, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall  
10 provide all necessary assistance to the Department of Rehabilitation  
11 Services to identify and transfer all real property held by or for  
12 the benefit of the Oklahoma School for the Blind and the Oklahoma  
13 School for the Deaf to the trust.

14 D. 1. The Commission for Rehabilitation Services may accept  
15 and receive any and all gifts, donations, devices, bequests, grants  
16 or contracts of any kind for money or property, either real or  
17 personal, for the benefit of the Oklahoma School for the Blind and  
18 the Oklahoma School for the Deaf.

19 2. The Commission is directed, authorized and empowered to hold  
20 such funds or property outright or in trust, invest or sell the  
21 property and use the principal or interest or proceeds of sale for  
22 the benefit of the Oklahoma School for the Blind and the Oklahoma  
23 School for the Deaf.

1       3. The Commission shall utilize its best efforts to comply with  
2 the terms of any conditional gift, devise or bequest in fulfillment  
3 of the donor's stipulations and provisions of applicable laws. Any  
4 real or personal property donated with conditions which are at any  
5 time determined to be infeasible to meet or continue may be returned  
6 to the donor, or if the donor is no longer living, if a natural  
7 person, or no longer a legally organized entity, for organizations,  
8 then the property may be sold and the proceeds of the sale deposited  
9 in the Commission's general fund or the property may be further  
10 donated in kind.

11       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
