7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to student transfers; amending 70
9 O.S. 2011, Section 8-103.2, which relates to
10 eligibility of student transfers in extramural
11 competitions; updating statutory reference; providing
12 certain exception to certain students who previously
13 attended a charter school and participated in the
14 charter school's competitions; providing an effective
15 date; and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 8-103.2, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 8-103.2. A. Except as otherwise provided, a student
20 who enrolls, pursuant to the Education Open Transfer Act or pursuant
21 to ~~Section 2 of this act~~ Section 8-113 of this title, in a school
22 district in which the student is not a resident shall not be
23 eligible to participate in school-related extramural athletic
24 competition governed by the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities
25 Association for a period of one (1) year from the first day of

1 attendance at the receiving school unless the transfer is from a
2 school district which does not offer the grade the student is
3 entitled to pursue.

4 B. If the student is granted an emergency transfer pursuant to
5 Section 8-104 of this title, was granted a transfer for any reason
6 prior to January 1, 2000, or enrolls pursuant to the Education Open
7 Transfer Act and qualifies for a hardship waiver pursuant to the
8 rules of the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association,
9 eligibility to participate in school-related extramural athletic
10 competition shall be determined by the Oklahoma Secondary School
11 Activities Association.

12 C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not
13 apply to a student who:

14 1. Was enrolled in a charter school established pursuant to
15 Section 3-132 of this title;

16 2. Was participating in the charter school's extramural
17 athletic competitions; and

18 3. Transfers to a public school district after the charter
19 school in which the student was enrolled ceases to operate for any
20 reason.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

22 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
24

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
