SENATE BILL 1250

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; defining term; requiring certain products to contain certain label; providing for promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1432 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. As used in this section, "vapor product" shall have the same meaning as provided by Section 1-229.12 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

B. Any vapor product sold in this state that contains alpha-tocopheryl acetate, also known as vitamin E acetate, shall bear a label stating that the product contains vitamin E acetate. The label shall contain a warning about the harmful effects of inhaling vitamin E acetate and the potential for injury or death.

C. The State Commissioner of Health shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.

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
