12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified						
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1432 of Title 63, unless there						
14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:						
15	A. As used in this section, "vapor product" shall have the same						
16	meaning as provided by Section 1-229.12 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma						
17	Statutes.						
18	B. Any vapor product sold in this state that contains alpha-						
19	tocopheryl acetate, also known as vitamin E acetate, shall bear a						
20	label stating that the product contains vitamin E acetate. The						
21	label shall contain a warning about the harmful effects of inhaling						
22	vitamin E acetate and the potential for injury or death.						
23	C. The State Commissioner of Health shall promulgate rules to						

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implement the provisions of this section.
