SENATE BILL 127

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public finance; requiring  
Legislature to present legislation allocating funds  
for certain state agencies or entities each year;  
providing for codification; and declaring an  
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.101 of Title 62, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

For any state agency or entity that is appropriated more than  
Seventy-five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000.00) in state funds, the  
Legislature shall present measures each year that allocate funds  
appropriated among the activities and programs provided for by law.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
