6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Public Competitive Bidding Act
8 of 1974; amending Section 3, Chapter 472, O.S.L. 2019
9 (61 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 103.8), which relates to
10 location of company headquarters; establishing that
11 reporting requirements apply to certain agencies;
12 deleting requirement that reporting obligations shall
13 apply to contracts awarded to out-of-state companies;
14 and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 472, O.S.L.
17 2019 (61 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 103.8), is amended to read as
18 follows:

19 Section 103.8. When a state agency with an annual payroll of
20 Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) or more accepts any type of
21 contract, whether bid or no-bid, it shall list the city, state and
22 country in which the company that is seeking or awarded work is
23 headquartered. If the company is an Oklahoma entity of which over
24 fifty percent (50%) is owned by an out-of-state entity or
individual, then, for the purposes of this section, the location of
the company's headquarters shall be considered to be in the city,

1 state and country of the majority owner. Any work the state awards
2 that is not strictly awarded by the lowest price ~~and that is awarded~~
3 ~~to a company not headquartered in Oklahoma~~ shall require the
4 awarding agency's director to provide reasons why the ~~out of state~~
5 company was chosen ~~over an Oklahoma company~~.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.

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
