SENATE BILL 1352

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to higher education; requiring certain colleges to offer a course in the U.S. Constitution; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3208.2 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Two-year colleges within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education shall, in accordance with Section 3208 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, offer a course in the U.S. Constitution and grant credit for such course.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
