Highways, bridges, and other facilities which 18 are part of the state highway system may be considered for 19 dedication in honor of individuals deserving of commendation for 20 their active involvement in the project or for outstanding service 21 to the nation, this state, or their community. Persons proposed to 22 be so honored shall have been deceased not less than three (3) years 23 prior to consideration, unless such person was an employee of the

Department of Transportation for not less than ten (10) years and

was actively involved in the planning, design, construction or maintenance of the state highway system. The provisions of this section shall not apply to the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway system designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces, members of law enforcement or firefighters fallen in the performance of their duties. The provisions of this section shall also not apply to the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway system designed to honor Medal of Honor recipients both living and deceased. Proposals for the dedication of state highway facilities should specifically state the accomplishments upon which the proposal is based.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
