SENATE BILL 1475

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to higher education; directing the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to develop certain model policy; requiring the policy to be adopted by the governing board of regents of certain institutions; providing for components of model policy; providing for promulgation of rules; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3206.7 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall establish a model policy which shall be adopted by the governing board of regents for each institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education regarding research conducted using facilities, property, faculty, staff or students within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education. The model policy shall:

1. Require disclosure of the source of data used in research;

1 2. Require disclosure of the source of funding to support
2 research;

3 3. Include a method to inform faculty, staff, students and
4 third parties conducting research on the premises of or with the
5 assistance of faculty, staff or students of an institution of the
6 policy adopted pursuant to this section; and

7 4. Address such other matters relating to the income and
8 expenses associated with the research, development, intellectual
9 property protection, marketing, distribution or other matters the
10 State Regents deem appropriate.

11 B. The State Regents shall promulgate rules to implement the
12 provisions of this section.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
