AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to school districts; directing an elementary school district to make certain payment to an independent school district to which a student transfers to attend a grade he or she is entitled to attend; providing for calculation of payment; directing the State Department of Education to provide certain assistance; directing that certain payment be included in certain State Aid calculation; providing for promulgation of rules; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-103.2 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. For each student who transfers from an elementary school district, which is the resident district of the student, to an independent district to attend a grade the student is entitled to pursue pursuant to Section 8-101 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statues, the elementary school district shall provide to the independent school district a proportional amount of monies derived

from the proceeds of the school levies made pursuant to the provisions of:

- 1. Subsection (a) of Section 9 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution;
- 2. Subsection (b) of Section 9 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution;
- 3. Subsection (c) of Section 9 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution;
- 4. Subsection (d) of Section 9 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution; and
- 5. Subsection (d-1) of Section 9 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution.
- B. The State Department of Education shall provide assistance to elementary school districts in calculating the amounts described in subsection A of this section and a schedule of payments.
- C. Payments made to an independent school district pursuant to subsection A of this section shall be included in the calculation of State Aid pursuant to Section 18-200.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- D. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules necessary to implement the provisions of this act.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
